The Water District would like to remind all residents that our Water Decree from the State governs the usage of water in Pinewood. According to the decree, water usage is limited to 200 gallons per day per household for in house use only, or 6000 gallons per month. This means *no outside watering*. Please see the complete Water Augmentation Plan listed under documents on the website [pswd.com](http://pswd.com). The above stipulation is on page 9. Also on our website are the District's Rules and regulations. Appendix A, beginning on page 17, clearly outlines the fines in place for exceeding 6000 gallons and the penalties for outside use of water.
