Water District

Colder temperatures are ahead. For all of you that don't live in your house year round, this is a reminder to have the water turned off at the meter, turn it off at the main shut off valve inside your home and drain your pipes.

Due to the recent water main break, there is still a lot of sediment in the water. If you are still experiencing low pressure, please check your whole house filters and your faucet aerators.

The Board is currently working on the proposed budget for 2013. Due to the high cost of chemicals, supplies, the continued increase in the amount of water testing that is required by the State and the repair or replacement of our aging equipment, residents will probably see another rate increase beginning February 1st 2013. A special meeting will be held sometime in the next few months to discuss the changes to the rate structure. Residents will be notified when that meeting is scheduled.
