### **Road Board**

From Sue Painter: Your road board crew typically works on Mondays in the neighborhood. They have been identifying and clearing ditches, culverts (public) and working on smoothing roads. Driveway culverts are the responsibility of the homeowner to clear and maintain. It is important that this be done on a yearly basis, as when they get plugged, they cause erosion across the road. We are working with the Fire Department to possibly offer to clear some homeowner culverts as a training exercise.
