The Applicant is seeking a finding of reasonable diligence for Maure Hollow Reservoir, Crescent Lake/Powelson Reservoir, Crow Lane Reservoir No. 1, Crow Lane Reservoir No. 2, and Pinewood Springs Reservoir as previously decreed in Division 1 Water Court Case Nos. 16CW3159, 10CW154, and 02CW347.

Prior to the entry of a decree by the Division One Water Court, the Division Engineer requests that the Referee consider and incorporate the following items in the ruling:

- The Court should verify that the work claimed for diligence has been steadily applied toward the completion of this water right within this diligence period and consistent with the Supreme Court holding in *Vermillion Ranch Ltd. P'ship v. Raftopoulos Bros.*, 2013 CO 41, 307 P.3d 1056.
