Larimer County code: No person may keep or feed any wild animal. However, feeding squirrels and birds, other than wild geese and ducks, is permitted. Feeding animals leads to their becoming a nuisance and more likely to be a perceived danger to children and pets and therefore killed, and it contributes to animals losing the skills to feed themselves which also endangers them.
