Road Board

Work around Pinewood continues; we will be finishing the area around the Seneca Bridge now that the major construction of both the bridge and water line has been completed. Upper Kiowa is on the list as well once the Kiowa Bridge to the Island is complete. The Water District has completed the Seneca Bridge Flood restoration. This project was paid for by a grant. The grant will also cover the Kiowa Cree Loop project scheduled to begin in late September. There have been six leaks on Kiowa and Ute Court Crossing in the last six weeks due to the increased truck traffic on Kiowa and Ute Court Crossing during the Kiowa-Bridge repair. The Water District has a Board member opening and that person must be able to attend most meetings. This term will last until the May 2016 election when a new four-year term will begin.
