For more information please access the Fire District website at [pinewoodspringsfire.org](http://pinewoodspringsfire.org). Select Services, then Fuels Reduction. Please read the local Burn Policy and then go to the Burn Permit link. FYI, Larimer County is only issuing permits to be used until December 31, 2019. You will have to reapply after January 1<sup>st</sup>, if you wish to burn slash next year.
